

# Point Community Scholarship Application Form

## Instructions:

To be considered for the Point Community Scholarship, you must be a first-term accepted student to a Point University online associate, bachelor's or master's degree program. Complete the following scholarship application and submit it to: [scholarships@point.edu](mailto:scholarships@point.edu). Applications will be reviewed by the Point Scholarship Committee and a recipient chosen. Please read the terms and conditions below and complete all fields in the form.

## Terms and conditions:

Unlike student loans, the Point Community Scholarship (PCS) never has to be repaid. Applicants must be first-term accepted students to a Point University online associate, bachelor's or master's degree program. They must complete the scholarship application and submit an essay explaining how their education will help them make a positive impact on their community. Requires a minimum prior cumulative GPA of 2.5. Only one PCS scholarship will be awarded per new academic session start. Award selection by Point Scholarship committee.

The potential scholarship value is based on a per credit hour tuition award over the life of the degree, therefore the total scholarship award will depend on the degree level and the number of credits remaining for the student: Up to a potential \$15,000 scholarship for an online bachelor's degree, up to \$7,500 for an online associate degree, and up to \$4,500 for an online master's degree. The scholarship is prorated based on the number of credits taken each semester. An amount of \$1500 will be applied for full-time students enrolled for 12 credit hours, and the amount of \$750 will be awarded to half-time students enrolled for 6 credit hours. The scholarship is applied each term over the life of the recipient's degree program (up to 120 credits for bachelor's, up to 60 credits for associate, up to 36 credits for master's).

Scholarship does not apply to on-campus programs and is not combinable with other offers. Scholarship award does not apply to transfer credits, credit waivers, or credits not completed. Students must maintain minimum 2.0 GPA and are subject to all standard student requirements. Offer expires Mar. 1st, 2018 and Point reserves the right to make changes to this scholarship program at any time.

The scholarship will be awarded over the life of my degree, and the total award amount will vary depending on how many credits I need to complete my program.
